APCDs are data systems that collect claims data from commercial and public payers, which hold the potential for a much deeper understanding of patterns, quality, and cost of care across populations.

RAPHIC is a federation of government, private, non-profit, and education organizations focused on improving the development and deployment of all payer claims databases. RAPHIC first convened in the summer of 2006 by the NH Citizens Health Initiative and University of New Hampshire staff, with the goal of engaging future users of the Maine and New Hampshire all payer healthcare claims databases in a discussion regarding multi-state collaboration. Currently, there are a dozen states participating in the monthly calls and email exchange: New Hampshire, Maine, Massachusetts, Vermont, Utah, Tennessee, Oregon, Minnesota, California, Wisconsin, New York, and Connecticut.

Over the course of the next 9 months, RAPHIC and UNH will be formally inventorying APCD efforts across the United States. We would like to know about the current APCD efforts in your state.
